Community Plan

A gentle reminder to all community groups and local businesses that we would like your thoughts on how as a village we can work more closely together to the benefit of all. Again, details are in the June issue, available on line as above. We are aiming for a draft Community Plan to be complete by the end of the summer and we really wish to ensure that all views are taken into account.

Neighbourhood Plan

Work is underway on many fronts and we will soon be approaching people who have kindly offered to help with evidence gathering about traffic in the village (a hot topic), likely future housing requirements of villagers and to gain an understanding of how peoples working lives are changing as a result of the pandemic. This

information will help us to plan more accurately. As and when you are approached for information, all of which will be anonymous, please do take part.

We are heading towards the next stage of the process where we put initial ideas to the village for your comments in an 'informal consultation'.

There will be a presentation to view in the village hall on

Wednesday 22nd July 6 pm - 9pm

and again on

Saturday July 25th 1pm – 4pm

Turn up at any time, see how the project is developing, ask questions and give us your feedback please.

Following on from this your views will be taken into account, the proposal developed further along with the necessary evidence base and then here will be a further 'formal consultation' in the autumn.

Finally, the completed proposal has to both be endorsed by an inspector as being suitable for adoption AND approved by the village in a referendum in 2022.
