



Exciting news: on November 14th Whitchurch Parish Council approved the draft Neighbourhood Plan to enter Regulation 14 consultation.

We are delighted to confirm that the draft Whitchurch Neighbourhood Plan will be available to all Whitchurch residents for review and comment on from December 1st. On that day it will also be provided to Buckinghamshire Council and multiple statutory bodies. The plan will be open for a seven-week consultation period.

What is in the plan?

- Details about any sites proposed for future housing
- Details of independent site assessments
- The policies that have shaped the selection of sites based on your views and a Housing Needs Assessment
- A comprehensive design guide with which new building must comply
- Details of green spaces and protected views that will gain additional protection through the NP

When do I need to comment by? : Consultation closes on January 21st

An open session (just turn up) to ask questions of the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group will be held on:

January 14th 2pm - 5pm

St John's Hall, Whitchurch

What happens then? : All comments will be reviewed and where appropriate the plan might be amended before being sent by Buckinghamshire Council to an independent inspector for final review. Once the review is complete a referendum will be held on the adoption of the plan - this will be a straight yes or no vote. We hope this will take place in the spring.
